

**SOUTH KING FIRE AND RESCUE
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

RESOLUTION NO. 525

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Fire Commissioners of South King Fire & Rescue (King County Fire Protection District #39), King County, Washington, that procurement of the UniMac Washer/Extractor and Drying Cabinet is a Sole Source Procurement and waiving competitive bidding.

WHEREAS, South King Fire & Rescue (KCFPD #39), King County, Washington (the "District") have been advised that the Fire Chief/Administrator has been provided with a formal legal opinion by legal counsel that procurement of the UniMac Washer/Extractor and Drying Cabinet is actually and legitimately limited to a single source of supply, because only the specific UniMac brand will satisfy the District's needs; and

WHEREAS, therefore competitive bidding is not required and is impractical;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF SOUTH KING FIRE & RESCUE (KCFPD #39), KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1.

UniMac is the sole source of the particular Washer/Extractor and Drying Cabinet, specifically needed by the District, in the State of Washington. The District has specified that the UniMac Washer/Extractor and Drying Cabinet is required due to the need for compatibility with existing systems in the fire stations owned or operated by the District. Consequently, this company, UniMac, is the sole source provided of the needed Washer/Extractor and Drying Cabinet, and therefore competitive bidding is impractical, is not required by law and is therefore hereby waived.

Section 2.

The legal opinion on this sole source procurement shall be maintained on file and attached to this Resolution.
