**RESOLUTION NO. 625**

**A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of  
South King Fire and Rescue (aka KCFPD #39), King County,  
Washington, Regarding the Adoption of the IFC Permit Fee Schedule**

**WHEREAS**, South King Fire & Rescue (SKFR) is a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Washington that has been delegated the authority to perform the fire prevention provisions of the International Fire Code (IFC) within the boundaries of SKFR, by interlocal agreement with the cities of Des Moines and Federal Way and Unincorporated King County; Resolution 625 supersedes and rescinds Resolution 605 and Resolution 596 and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners considered the cost associated with the dedication of personnel and resources to the work of inspecting, approving and issuing IFC permits and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners, after considering these costs has decided that applicants for certain permits should bear the costs associated with the issuance of said permits.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of SKFR as follows:

- a. SKFR hereby adopts the following fee schedule for IFC Permits required by the codes adopted by the respective jurisdictions: See the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference.
- b. SKFR reserves the ability to modify the fees set forth in Exhibit A without notice. At any time the fees are modified, a new Exhibit A shall be appended to this resolution and shall supersede the previous Exhibit A.
- c. This resolution shall take effect on January 1, 2023.





Nonprofit 501(c)(3) Organizations: 50% reduction on all fees

All Operational fees are billed via a third-party vendor on behalf of SKFR are subject to a \$18.50 service fee per occupancy.

**Construction Permit Fee Schedule:**

RESIDENTIAL – Install, remove or decommission per tank	\$ 50.00
COMMERICAL – Install, remove or decommission per tank	\$ 120.00
TEMPORARY MEMBBRANE STRUCTURES AND TENTS	\$ 120.00
SOLAR PANEL (PV Systems)	\$ 120.00
ALL OTHER PERMIT TYPES *	\$ 120.00

\*This fee schedule excludes permit types that are issued through the city of Des Moines and Federal Way Building Departments

Permit fee covers up to ½ hour of a plan and code review, initial site inspection, and two reinspection's. Additional plan review time, site visits and, additional reinspection's to secure compliance are billed at \$100 for visits three and four, and \$300 for visits five and higher.

Any Construction fee billed via a third-party vendor on behalf of SKFR are subject to a \$18.50 service fee per occupancy. Construction fee's collected by the City of Federal Way or the City of Des Moines are subject to any service fee they charge.
