RESOLUTION NO. 635

A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of South King Fire & Rescue rescinding and replacing Resolution No. 332 and Resolution 433 and authorizing and directing the expenditure of District funds in recognition of major events in the lives of District employees under specific circumstances

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 332 authorized the expenditure of \$50 or less, and Resolution 433 authorized the expenditure of \$75 or less, for an appropriate recognition of events in the lives of District employees, such as for hospitalization of an employee or family member, death of the employee or family member, or other events at the discretion of the Board and/or the Fire Chief and Executive Director; and

WHEREAS, a memorandum has been received from the Washington State Attorney General's Office in reply to a request from the State Auditor's Office for advice on the legality of the above; and

WHEREAS, the advice received is that the Board of Commissioners must list the specific events in employees' lives to be recognized;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of South King Fire & Rescue that Resolution Nos. 332 and 433 be rescinded and replaced by this Resolution No. 635, and be it FURTHER RESOLVED that an expenditure of \$200 or less (adjusted by inflation as necessary) is hereby authorized for an appropriate recognition of the following events in the lives of District employees:

1. Flowers, or similar decorative items, may be sent to District employees with a serious illness, injury, or surgery.
2. Flowers, or similar decorative items, may be sent on the death of a District employee or District employee's immediate family member (in these situations, flowers will be sent to the employee). Immediate family for this purpose shall include spouse, children, and parents and step-relations equivalent to those listed.
3. Greeting cards may be sent to District employees under the following circumstances: employee birthdays, birth or adoption of a child, or to express sympathy or a "get well" message.




