

**SOUTH KING FIRE
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

RESOLUTION NO. 673

**A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of
South King Fire, King County, Washington,
Repealing and Replacing Resolution No. 612 and Resolution 523 Delegating
authority to approve change orders on construction projects within certain
described limits.**

WHEREAS, the District is in the process of completing public works pursuant to construction contracts for remodeling of several fire stations and district properties; and

WHEREAS, the District will have construction contracts in the future; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen circumstances there may be a need for the District to execute and agree to change orders in a very timely and efficient manner without waiting for Board approval;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners heretofore adopted Resolution 523 and Resolution 612, which now will be superseded and replaced by this Resolution No. 673, due to changes in personnel;

NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

Section 1: The Board of Commissioners hereby delegates its authority to Assistant Chief of Planning Eric Suckoll to execute and agree to Change Orders on all public works construction contracts up to and not to exceed the limits set forth in this resolution.

Section 2: Assistant Chief of Planning Eric Suckoll is authorized to execute such Change Orders on behalf of the District, on any such construction contract, up to a maximum amount, in the aggregate for such contract, not to exceed 3% of the contract price, not including Washington State Sales Tax (WSST). For example, if the contract amount, exclusive of WSST were \$4,000,000.00, the change order maximum would be \$120,000.00 in the aggregate, without first obtaining Board approval.

Section 3: In addition, the maximum single change order, for which Assistant Chief of Planning Eric Suckoll shall have approval authority without consulting the Board of Commissioners, shall be \$50,000.00 (this amount currently needs double signature via Board Resolution for purchases)


