RESOLUTION NO. 518

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Fire Commissioners of South King Fire & Rescue (aka KCFPD #39), King County, Washington, Authorizing the Donation of Surplus Departmental Equipment

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of South King Fire & Rescue to surplus the department-owned equipment listed below:


- 85 – MSA SCBA's
- 177 – MSA 45 minute cylinders
- 19 – MSA 60 minute cylinders
- 170 – MSA Masks
- 7 – RIT bags with regulators

WHEREAS, this equipment is no longer used and has been deemed dispensable; South King Fire & Rescue will coordinate the surplus of the following equipment that has no value on the secondary market to the Cabo San Lucas Fire Department Bomberos Voluntarios in Mexico. In the past SKF&R has donated similar equipment to the aforementioned fire department that has a need for upgrading their fire department equipment. Shipping will be coordinated so that SKF&R incurs no cost, OR

WHEREAS, the equipment listed is beyond serviceable repair; South King Fire & Rescue hereby disclaims any warranty of any kind, including any warranty of fitness for a particular purpose and warranty of merchantability, with respect to such equipment. The transfer of such equipment is made AS IS, WITH ALL FAULTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners hereby authorizes the South King Fire & Rescue Fire Chief/Administrator, and/or his designee, to surplus the above listed equipment and proceed with the donation.




